# Introduction

- Education is a crucial component of any effective effort to eliminate child labor.
- Education increases individual earnings
- If workers from poor and rich backgrounds received the same education, disparity between the two in working poverty could decrease by 39%
- Educational attainment explains about half of the difference in growth rates between East Asia and Sub-Saharan Africa between 1965 and 2010.



# Finding:

- Almost 70 million children across the world are prevented from going to school each day, a study published today reveals.
- There will be more children out of school than there are today, unless the richest countries dramatically increase the aid they give to the poorest nations.
- Girls are far less likely to attend school than boys in many of the world's poorest countries, the authors have found. In Malawi, of those that enroll, 22.3% of boys complete primary compared to 13.8% of girls. In rural Burkina Faso, 61% of girls are married by the age of 18 and over 85% never get to see the inside of a secondary school.

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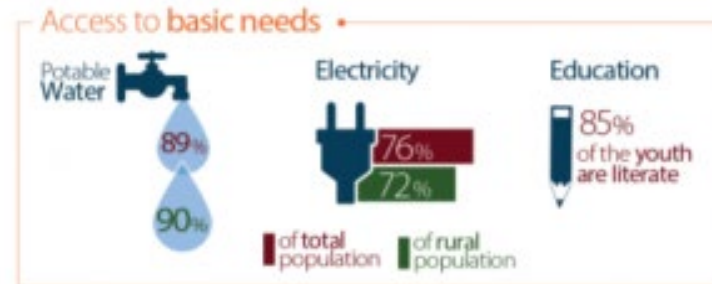
